The first year of kits used in Clubs are for the **Junior Engineering** series of models.

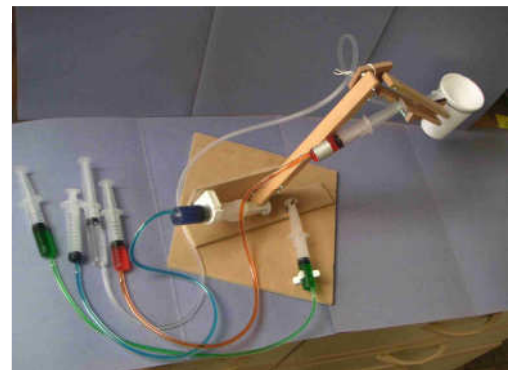

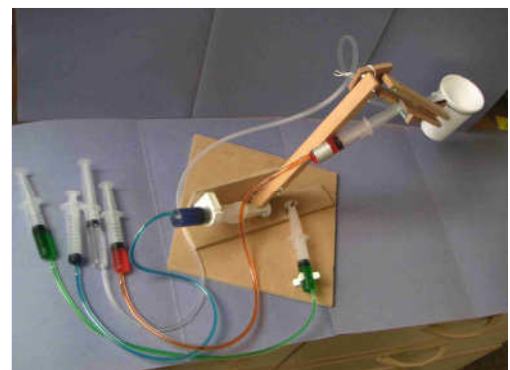
